We will spend the next few weeks working with short stories. I will determine the groups; fate will determine the text; the sorting hat will determine the date. Here are the texts:

Eudora Welty	"Why I Live at the P.O."

Beginning on Thursday, you will have a week—four English class periods—to:

- (1) Read your story 2 3 times to understand its content & structure
- (2) Research the author, context, and various critical approaches to the text
- (3) Create a handout or slideshow to introduce your author & text
- (4) Develop supplementary materials (worksheet, diagram, character map, etc.) to help your classmates understand the text
- (5) Prepare a brief and fair reading quiz: questions, answer key, grading rubric
- (6) Provide me with 3 4 appropriate "sto-cab" words
- (7) Design & print three 8.5" x 11" posters to hang in the classroom: (a) an image of the author; (b) an image representing the text; (c) an appropriate quote
- (8) Plan to deliver a 45-minute lesson

<u>You</u> will grade your classmates on their understanding and participation. I will grade <u>you</u> on your effort, your time management, the quantity and quality of your work, and the delivery of your lesson. At the end of this unit there will be a final examination covering ALL of these stories.
