Unit I: Judaism and Christianity

Judaism and Christianity are building blocks in the foundation of Western Civilization, and familiarity with these great world religions and their sacred Scripture is an essential component of cultural literacy. In this unit we will explore the history of Ancient Israel, the life of Christ as it is recounted in the Gospels, and the formation of the early Christian Church. As we review stories from the Bible, we will consider how these stories fit together into larger narratives. We will also identify basic beliefs about God, humanity, and the world that have had a profound impact on Western thought.
