## **OUR STUDENTS**

#### MATH

### MathLeague National Competition:

Twelve students qualified with a team finish of 8th place nationally out of 114 teams and an award of Honorable Mention; one student placed 2nd nationally.

### **SCIENCE**

#### Award Winning Lady's Slipper Research:

New Hampshire Academy of Science peer-reviewed the research of eight eighth grade students and accepted their submissions that qualified them to present their research to the American Association for the Advancement of Science in 2016 in Washington DC.

Eight eighth grade students presented their research at the international science symposium of the American Association for the Advancement of Science in San Jose, CA.

One eighth grade student published a research article in a national orchid journal.

#### Caroline Bradley Scholarship Award Winner:

Partially based on her Lady's Slipper research, a middle school student was the only student in New England and one of 29 students in the country selected for this highly competitive merit-based scholarship.

Team of students won "Best in Region" in a national search of approximately 1100 app concepts.

• First Lego League Team:

1st place award for Core Values for excellence in teamwork

Solar Sprint Competition:

Using our new 3-D printer, students designed cars that placed 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th in the NH / VT regional competition.

Median Crossroads student score on year-end exams:

Math: 98th percentile | Reading: 95th percentile | Writing: 95th percentile
